TREATMENT FACILITIES CHAIR

Help bring A.A. meetings and “Bridging the Gap” support to those leaving treatment centers. Coordinate with local districts, maintain contacts, and share Grapevine subscriptions.



GRAPEVINE / LITERATURE CHAIR

Be the link between members and A.A. materials! Keep literature displays current, bring them to workshops and assemblies, and promote Grapevine reps in groups. Sell literature on an individual basis (not in competition with any group, district or Intergroup). Assets not to exceed \$5,000.



CORRECTIONS CHAIR

Carry the message behind the walls. Support A.A. meetings in correctional facilities and help guide committees through training and assistance. Acts in an advisory capacity to district corrections chairpersons and D.C.M.s on corrections work. May be available to talk on committee work at G.S.R. meetings.



ACCESSIBILITY CHAIR

Make A.A. available to all who seek it. Provide information to districts about accessibility issues and encourage districts to have an accessibility chair. Participates in the Language Steering committee and facilitates the Remote Communities subcommittee.
